# **Enter Hot Spring**

## Location of the Hot Spring and how to enter

- There is an NPC located at the entrance to the village in Ruben and Ranox. Pressing the Z key activates a pop-up window that lets you enter. (The NPC location is show on the village map).
- The message 'Only characters with level 10 or higher can enter' is displayed when a user tries to enter the springs with a character below level 10.

## **Entry with CoBo Express (using ED)**

- Characters below level 10 cannot enter.
- Charming Geyser (Hot Spring) is displayed in the CoBo Express list when Ranox can be entered.
- The Hot Spring is shown in first place at the very top of the list.

## **Structure of the Hot Spring**

#### Ruben - Soul Waterfall (Hot Spring), Ranox - Charming Geyser (Hot Spring)

- The same conditions apply as in the village (you can sit on mounts, summon pets, use chat, sit, you can't use skills, etc.).
- The Hot Springs are split into the areas 'Ventus Pool' and 'Agaur Pool'. The 'Ventus Pool' area contains an NPC who explains the Hot Springs to the player.
- There is a portal located at either end of the Hot Springs that lets the player teleport back to the village.

# **Effects of the Hot Springs**

## The buffs 'Ventus Blessing' and 'Agaur Blessing' can be obtained in the Hot Springs.

Buff information

| Buff name       | Conditions                    | Buff effect  |
|-----------------|-------------------------------|--|
| Ventus Blessing | Spend 6 min. in 'Ventus Pool' | +100% EXP (PvP, dungeon) * Dungeons also include fields.   |
| Agaur Blessing  | Spend 6 min. in 'Agaur Pool'  | Increases damage bonus, critical hit, attack speed and devastation by 10% (in a dungeon).  * Dungeons also include fields. |

- The buff remains active for 20 min. and cannot be stacked.
- The buff duration starts again as soon as the character has spent 6 min. close to the Hot Spring.
- An effect is displayed during the buff waiting period. (If you sit on the field, the effect is displayed that's shown on the right of the screen.)
- You can only receive one buff at a time.
- If you leave the Hot Spring during the buff waiting period or enter the village, the time accumulated disappears.
- If you stay near the Hot Spring, the screen displays the buff name, the time remaining until you receive the buff and the description.
- If the character wears the bathing style, the time you wait to receive the buff reduces by 50%. (With Lu/Ciel it's enough for the character to simple wear the look.)

#### Double the speed of endurance regeneration on mounts

- Double the speed of endurance regeneration for mounts as soon as the character is located near a Hot Spring.
- The endurance is also regenerated at double the speed if the character does not sit on the mount.
- The endurance is displayed in a different colour.
- If you drag your mouse over the endurance, the tool-tip shown below is displayed.

#### The SD displayed is displayed with changes to match the Hot Spring.

• The SD is displayed as follows, no matter which avatar is currently equipped.

# **Editing for character login in the Hot Spring**

- The character is logged in to the Guild Headquarters.
- The character out of Guild Headquarters directly into the Hot Spring.
- If the character has logged out in the Hot Spring but it's no longer possible to enter the Hot Spring, they will be logged in to the village (Hot Spring in Ruben -> Ruben).
